
Create your Reverse Outline

Peer Review to focus on structure

Reverse Outline:

- Start with their final paragraph. Read it and then, in one sentence or less describe what the paragraph says. (on the left side of the T)
- (2) Do this for every paragraph from the end to the beginning
- (3) When you finish. Then look at the left side of the T and fill out the right side. Think about your peer's takeaway: Does the current structure lead you to this takeaway? Is there information you need to get to the takeaway? Where should it go? Why?

Reflect on the reverse outline:

Describe the current structure of the paper. Do you think there is a reason for this structure? Does the structure help communicate meaning? How?
